Nina Packer is a woman with a heart for God. She relies on the precepts of Proverbs 31 to guide her steps as a woman of excellence in ministry, motherhood, and the marketplace. Her life is multifaceted and fruitful because she is anchored by and employs her faith in all endeavors, seeking to live a life that honors and is pleasing to God. Nina is a faithful and fervent servant member of Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church in Atlanta, GA, under the leadership of Rev. Phillip Spann, Senior Pastor and Teacher. She avails her spiritual gifts by the grace of God to extend the ministry of Jesus Christ as a prayer intercessor for Shiloh's Intercessory Prayer Ministry and as Operations Coordinator for the church's nonprofit outreach arm, SALT Ministries of Atlanta (Shiloh Adhering to the Lord's Teachings).

Her endeavors as a disciple of Christ are also blessed in the Atlanta community. Nina supports the innovation and vitality of education by serving as a volunteer board member for charter and traditional K-12 public schools. She served from 2016-18 as a board member of Women After God's Own Heart Ministry, a community ministry aimed at addressing the special concerns of females by presenting biblical principles and precepts in a manner by which they can mature spiritually and positively impact the community.

It is in her experiences as a mother to her two daughters, Nija and Maya Packer, that Nina has come to know God intimately.
